Are you a Veteran or a Veteran family who is homeless or at risk of homelessness?

Goodwill Industries of New Mexico's Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program can help very-low-income Veteran families stabilize their housing situation and more.

You may qualify for assistance if you are a homeless Veteran or at risk of homelessness who was discharged under conditions other than dishonorable. SSVF may be able to help with:

- Case Management
- Assistance with obtaining VA and other public benefits
- Temporary financial assistance which may include: time-limited payments for rent, utilities, moving expenses, security and utility deposits, transportation, child-care and emergency supplies
- Linking to needed healthcare services, daily living services, financial planning, housing counseling, job development, legal services, fiduciary and payee services

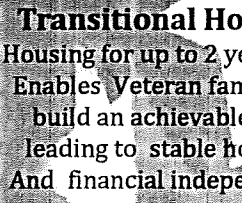

Short-term housing for Veterans & their families that are literally homeless throughout New Mexico



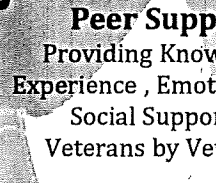
Transitional Housing

- Vets4Warriors provides peer support and follow up for those with ongoing concerns. For those in crisis we will connect you to the Military Crisis Line.



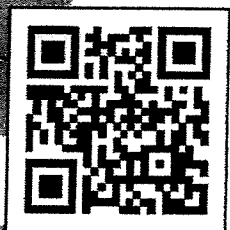
- The Vets4Warriors call center is staffed with Veterans and family members representing all branches of the Service.
